We are offering the Rifle Shooting Merit Badge this spring. We'll guide the Scout through all of the Rifle Shooting requirements from loading—unloading to cleaning a rifle as well as making sure they shoot their best. This class requires the Scout to complete a workbook before coming to the class. Everything they need will be provided. We organize the class in patrols of six Scouts.
